Early Years Program Educator Overview

- Reporting directly to the Moss Rock Preschool Manager, this is a 30 hour a week position on a ten month contract.

Responsibilities:

- Work collaboratively with our the Early Years Team
- Provide direct supervision of the children in our Early Years Program
- Build strong relationships with children, families and colleagues
- Make learning and thinking visible through the creation and use of pedagogical Narrations.
- With the support of the entire ECE team, coordinate, plan and deliver high quality, child-centered child care services for a program of 16 children ages 3-5
- Act in accordance with the FGCA policies and procedures as well as within the requirements of all governing agencies
- Attend staff meetings, and other community meetings when necessary
- Support related FGCA activities events and generally promoting the mission of the association

Qualifications

- Direct experience working in a licensed care setting
- Must hold a current Early Childhood Educator Certification OR Early Childhood Educator Assistant Certificate with ECE pending
- Strong written and oral communication and interpersonal skills
- Competency in using technology in writing narrations
- First aid certificate and clear criminal record check
- Experience working in a daycare setting that uses pedagogical narrations as part of its' practice
