## **Clover Point Pump Station: Preparation of Temporary Laydown Area**

The Clover Point Pump Station will be upgraded and expanded as part of the Wastewater Treatment Project. The current pump station pumps sewage directly into the ocean. The expanded pump station will pump wastewater to the McLoughlin Point Wastewater Treatment Plant for tertiary treatment and provide bypass pumping to the existing outfall during storm events. The contractor for this part of the Project, Kenaidan Contracting Ltd, will begin to construct a laydown area at Clover Point, west of the current pump station. The work includes:

- Construction of temporary laydown area, installation of trailers
- Construction of a chain-link perimeter fence
- Install temporary power feed to laydown area

### **Work Description**

- Geotextile cloth will first be installed within the laydown area
- Earthworks equipment will be used to supply and install gravel to construct the laydown area
- Temporary construction fencing and screening will surround perimeter of work area
- Signage will be posted prior to work

### **Traffic Impacts**

- No street closures will be required.
- On average 5-10 trucks per day (roundtrips) will be bringing equipment and materials to and from the site at Clover Point for approximately 15 days.
- Path access will not be affected except within the laydown fenced area. The shoreline walkway will remain open throughout construction.

**Start Date:** Week of January 22, 2018

**Work Hours:** 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday

**Location:** The laydown area will be constructed to the south of Dallas Road and to the west of Clover Point Road. The laydown area will be returned to its pre-construction state.

### **About the Wastewater Treatment Project**

The Wastewater Treatment Project will provide tertiary treatment for wastewater from the core area municipalities of Victoria, Esquimalt, Saanich, Oak Bay, View Royal, Langford and Colwood, and the Esquimalt and Songhees First Nations and will be complete by the end of 2020.



Kenaidan Contracting Ltd is the contractor selected by the CRD to design, build and expand the current Clover Point Pump Station. Construction on the expanded Clover Point Pump Station will begin in early 2018 and will be complete in mid-2020. The laydown area is anticipated to be used for the duration of the construction period and will be returned to its current, pre-construction state after the work is complete.
