Dear Resident,

This fall, the City of Victoria will be constructing a bioswale system along the north side of Richardson Street between Kipling Street and Arnold Avenue.

The bioswale is designed to convey runoff through a trench while allowing it to infiltrate through a soil bed and into the ground. A bioswale system combines aspects of grass swales and infiltration trenches. The surface component of a bioswale is a shallow planted channel, accepting flows from areas of adjacent surfaces.

Construction is scheduled to begin in mid-October, and will be completed by mid-November. We anticipate minimal disruption to the neighbourhood and traffic.

We appreciate your patience and understanding while we strive to improve the municipal infrastructure in your neighbourhood. The City of Victoria will work to minimize any impacts to residents during construction. The construction area will be clearly marked with signs.
