The City has engaged Don Mann Excavating Ltd. as the prime contractor. All efforts are focused on maintaining a safe work site while mitigating impacts to residents, businesses, and commuters wherever possible.

Working hours are typically Monday through Friday from 7am – 5pm, however some weekend work be completed to take advantage of weather. Stakeholders will be notified in advance of any night work.

These virtual updates provide an overview of where works will generally occur. Temporary parking removal and detour routes, including for Public Transit, may be in effect to accommodate works. Keep posted to BC Transit website alerts for real time route information. Please be prepared to follow the direction of crews and respect construction zone and school zone speed limits. Your patience is appreciated.

## **RICHARDSON STREET:**

NOTICE OF WEEKEND WORK: On Saturday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021, light construction work will be starting at 7:30am between Carnsew St. and Minto St.

- Cook Street Intersection: Road Works. This will involve concrete work for curbs, and preparation for paving for traffic signal installation. Road and sidewalk access will be maintained, while drivers and cyclists should expect delays. Please use caution in the area.
- 2. Kipling to Moss Street: Full Road Paving. Milling and paving work is expected to start on September 27<sup>th</sup> and last a full week, dependent on weather. During road paving activities, motorists and cyclists should detour. Parking will be restricted in some zones. Noise and dust from asphalt removal as well as odor from new paving is anticipated. Those residents located in directly impacted zones have received separate detailed notifications.
- 3. Lotbiniere Intersection: Neighbourhood Plaza Construction. This will involve milling and paving and finishing concrete work for new curbs and seating. Local vehicle access will be retained during construction. Those riding bicycles may be asked to stop and dismount. Pedestrians should use caution in this zone. Noise from asphalt removal as well as odor from new paving are anticipated.
- St. Charles to Richmond Ave: Sidewalk and Curb Work. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Temporary parking restrictions may be in place for worksite accommodation.
- 5. **Foul Bay at Richardson- Preparation work for landscaped median.** Pedestrians may be re-routed and should use caution. The intersection will remain open for those driving east on Richardson across Foul Bay Road.

## KINGS/HAULTAIN CORRIDOR:

This project is now getting underway. Transit service will remain on Haultain Road until later this fall. Notifications about the #22 route shift to Bay Street will be posted on BC Transit's website and on physical stops on Haultain Street.

1. **Shelbourne Street - Road Markings and Traffic Diverter Installation.** Work will be focused between Haultain and Bay Street and will involve preparation and installation of road markings.

On Thursday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, the new traffic diverter will be installed at the intersection and motorists traveling northbound on Shelbourne Street will no longer be able to turn left on to Haultain Street.

- Shelbourne at Haultain Intersection- Underground Work. Work will involve road excavation in preparation for upgrades removal of traffic signals and new rapid flashing beacons and crosswalk. Expect minor delays if driving or cycling.
- 3. Belmont at Haultain intersection- Road Excavation. Expect minor delays if driving or cycling.
- 4. **Fernwood Intersection- Potential Underground Work.** This will involve road excavation. When work occurs, expect minor delays if driving or cycling.
