## Update: Water Main Lining Project Cowichan Street - Brighton Avenue to Quamichan Street

This July, the Cowichan Street water main lining project that started earlier this year will resume. The project is anticipated to finish in the beginning of September. Thank you for your patience while this critical infrastructure work is completed.

### Scope of work includes the following:

- **Temporary Water Services:** Temporary water services for houses on Cowichan St (from Brighton Ave to Quamichan Street) will be installed while the existing watermain is being relined and rehabilitated.
- **Relining Existing Watermain:** A new liner will be applied to the existing main before being returned to service and the temporary services removed.

The City of Victoria will work to minimize inconveniences during construction. Local access will be maintained and some temporary parking restrictions will be required. The construction area will be clearly marked with signs.

Crews will install the new water main lining using a modern trenchless installation method to minimize impacts to residents and reduce construction costs. Brief interruptions in water service may occur while services are being transferred to and from the temporary connections. 48 hours advance notice will be provided should any significant interruption be anticipated.
